Attendance Policy

The AFJROTC After-School Program is designed to introduce 9th and 10th graders to Aerospace Science, Leadership Education and Drill. The course is offered on a pass/fail basis. An attendance rate of 70% is required in order pass and to earn the 60 contact hours in order to receive the ½ elective credit.

Classes are held on Thursdays, after-school beginning at 3:00 PM, (no-later than 3:15 PM) and concluding at 5:30 PM. Students must provide their own transportation.

Student Discipline Policy

It is the expectation that the students coming to TCTC for the AFJROTC class want to be in this class to learn and will behave in accordance with the TCTC student handbook and OH-20051 Cadet Guide.
