What is Dual Enrollment?

- ▶ Being enrolled in high school and college at the same time!
- ▶ Students take a college class in their high school during their regular school, taught by their regular high school teacher, surrounded by their regular classmates!

How Does It Work?

- ▶ YSU certifies teacher as part-time, adjunct faculty
- ▶ High school classroom becomes off-site YSU classroom
- ▶ Instructor teaches the YSU syllabus for the approved course
- ▶ Students apply through the CHS Coordinator at their district
- ▶ A final grade is posted in two places-- (1) High School Transcript (2) College Transcript



Benefits...

1. **Money-** College in High School tuition is \$49 per credit hour (as opposed to almost \$300 per credit hour on campus).
2. **Transferability of Credits-** The YSU transcript can be transferred to any State of Ohio institution, as well as many other private and out-of-state schools.
3. **Library Access-** An extended YSU campus ID will be made for each CHS student providing access to all Maag Library resources.

Eligibility...

- ▶ To take part in College in High School, a student must:
 1. Be enrolled as a Junior or Senior in High School
 2. Have an overall GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
 3. Have an ACT composite score of 23 and an English subset score of 23...**OR**...test into YSU English 1550 using the English Placement Exam
- ▶ Eligibility requirements and explanation of testing is available in the application booklet.
