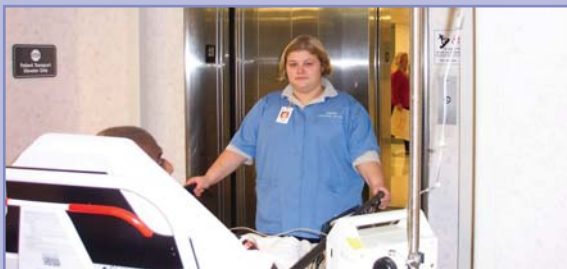
about the program...

brief overview

Hospitality Services prepares students for a variety of positions in the fast-growing hospitality industry. The program curriculum includes the START (Skills, Tasks and Results Training) program from the Educational Institute of the American Hotel & Lodging Association. In the first year, students work through a rotation of in-school job sites. Second year students train with employee mentors at an area hospital four days a week. Students take all required academic classes for high school graduation. A variety of support services are available to help ensure student success.
