Course Description: Mathematics is an essential part of everyday life. Upper level Mathematics helps to increase problem-solving skills and has been shown to improve performance in other academic endeavors. Algebra II is taken after successful completion of the Integrated Courses or Algebra I and Geometry. The Course is worth 1 Math Credit and lasts 2 Semesters.

Instructional Philosophy: Students will be expected to keep a notebook and will have frequent homework. Class time includes note taking, problem solving and occasional projects and/or presentations. Methods of assessment will include grading of homework, notebooks, quizzes, test and projects. Students will be expected to keep all notes and assignments throughout the course in a folder/notebook. We will be utilizing the textbook, TI-83 Plus graphing calculator technology, the computer and smartboard to accomplish the objectives of the course.

- scientific calculator (TI-83 Plus/84 recommended but not required)

Course Goals:

- Demonstrate knowledge of Algebra II topics found in the Trumbull County Course of Study and the Ohio Department of Education Standards for Mathematics
- Be able to apply this mathematics to everyday life
- Become better problem solvers
- Develop more critical thinking skills through problem solving
- Be better able to use technology for mathematical purposes

Possible Topics to be covered:

- Operations on numbers and expressions including real and complex numbers
- Linear and non-linear equations and inequalities
- Polynomial and rational functions
- Function operations and inverses
- Data and statistics
- Matrices
- Conic Sections
- Logarithmic functions
- Trigonometric functions
